- Namsan Shuttle Bus (Circulation Bus)

\* **Circulation Bus No. 2:** Chungmuro Station (Seoul Subway Lines 3 & 4), Exit 2 (in front of Daehan Cinema) or Dongguk University Station (Seoul Subway Line 3), Exit 6 (Intervals: 16 min / First bus 07:00, Last bus 23:30)

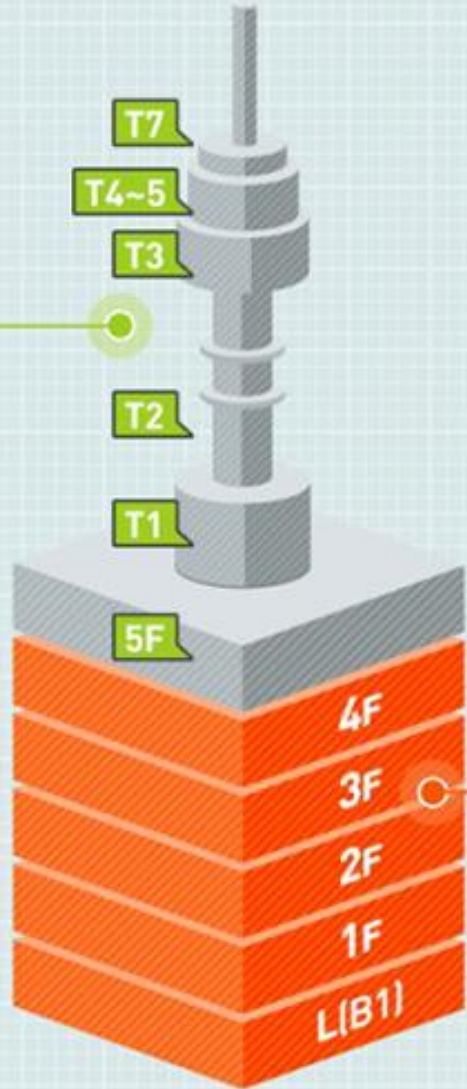

# Locks of Love



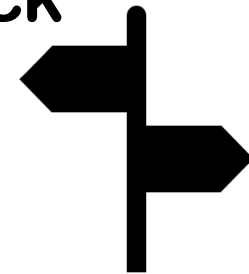
Near the base of the tower – level T2- you can find a variety of shops, cafes, and restaurants.

## The Observatory Deck (T4~T5)



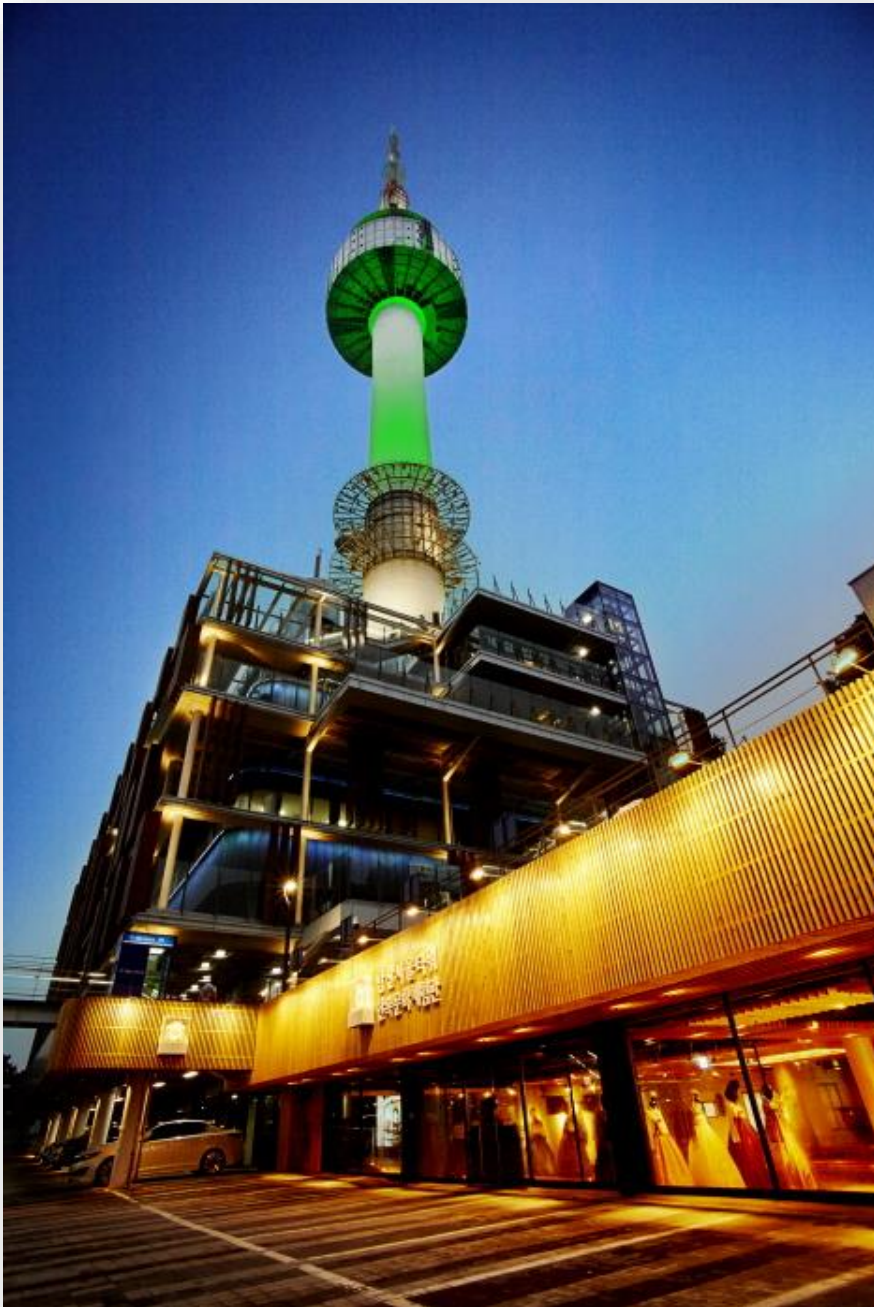
